• Gastrointestinal disorders are commonly seen in children and adolescents. These discomforts include constipation, abdominal pain, gastroenteritis, gastroesophageal reflux, and irritable bowel syndrome. With the westernization change of diet and the pressure from the external environment, more and more children and adolescents suffer from these diseases. Examinations such as abdominal sonography and endoscopy are often required make the appropriate diagnoses.

Obesity/overweight with non-alcoholic fatty liver disease is the major causes of

abnormal liver function in children and adolescents. They can lead to inflammation, liver fibrosis or even cirrhosis in the long-term follow -up. Early detection and timely intervention with weight control/proper exercise can revert this situation. This method could also promote a healthier life style.

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
