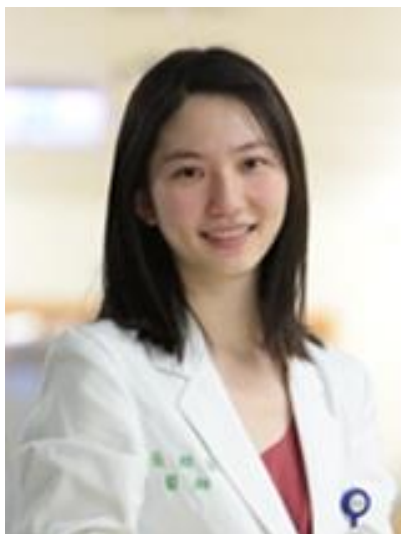

• **Reminder from Dr. Chang:**

Two major oral diseases, dental caries and periodontal disease, are caused by bacteria, and may result in loss of tooth structure, pulpitis, pulp necrosis, increased mobility of tooth, and even tooth loss.
